PENTECOST 20

Very few of us will be asked to sell everything that we have, but all of us are commanded to set aside any idol that may be present in our lives. We must all give up relying on our own moral efforts to earn salvation and instead embrace the grace that alone can redeem us from the curse of sin and death. Today we confront all that our culture tells us will make us happy and fulfilled, and yet, Jesus says it will never be enough. It wasn't the money that hindered the rich young man—it was his self-sufficiency. God does for his children what they can't do for themselves. Inheritance is not earned but given.
